ORDINANCE 2003-01  
Passed and Adopted  
January 14, 2003

An ordinance of the City of Sedona, Arizona, adopting by reference as Section 9-5-1 through Section 9-5-18, that public record entitled “City of Sedona Body Art Regulations”; providing for a savings clause; and providing for repeal of any ordinance or part of ordinances or code provisions in conflict therewith.

ORDINANCE 2003-02

An ordinance of the City of Sedona, Arizona, amending the City of Sedona Land Development Code Article 3 (Decision making and administrative bodies), Article 4 (Review procedures), Article 6, (District regulations), Article 15 ( Historic Preservation Ordinance) and providing that all ordinances or parts of ordinances or any part of the Land Development Code in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed upon the effective date of this ordinance.

An ordinance of the City of Sedona, Arizona, rezoning that property described herein from its present designation of RM-2 (Multi-Family Residential) to RS-18-A (Single Family Residential); establishing conditions of such rezoning; directing the amendment of the zoning map upon completion of all zoning conditions set forth herein; providing that all ordinances or parts of ordinances or any part of the Land Development Code in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed upon the effective date of this ordinance.
