ACTION MINUTES

The Personnel Board met on Monday, March 1, Tuesday, March 2 and Thursday, March 4, 2010 to conduct a hearing in connection with the appeal of Jeremy Ebert. Opening statements were made by Michael Goimarac, City of Sedona City Attorney, and Martin Bihn, Jeremy Ebert's Attorney. The witnesses that testified on Monday, March 1, 2010 starting at 5:02 p.m. were Michael Dominguez, City of Sedona Police Detective, and Jeremy Ebert, former City of Sedona Police Officer. The Board adjourned for the evening at 10:04 p.m.

On Tuesday, March 2, 2010, starting at 4:00 p.m. the board reconvened in the Vultee conference Room located at 102 Roadrunner Drive, Sedona Az. The witnesses that testified were; Timothy Ernster, City of Sedona City Manager; Joe Vernier, former City of Sedona Police Chief; Walter Spokes, City of Sedona Police Sergeant; John Hutchinson, Mr. Ebert's expert witness; James Pott, City of Sedona Police Officer; and Lucas Wilcoxson, City of Sedona Police Sergeant. Following testimony of all witnesses the Board heard closing arguments and adjourned for the evening at 9:15 p.m.

The Board then reconvened on Thursday, March, 4, 2010, at 3:30 p.m. and went into executive session to deliberate. Following the executive session the Personnel Board returned to open meeting and made the following decision:

It is the decision of the Personnel Board of the City of Sedona that just cause has been established in the dismissal of Jeremy Ebert from employment with the City of Sedona, that proper procedures were followed in this dismissal, and that the Board affirms and concurs with the termination action in this case.

The meeting adjourned at 6:14 p.m.
