COMMUNITY CLEAN UP DAY

(FOR COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY)

SATURDAY JUNE 5TH 7:00AM - 4:00PM ONLY
AT FLAGSTAFF'S CINDER LAKES LANDFILL

REDUCE THE THREAT OF FIRE ON YOUR PROPERTY

1. Remove leaf & pine needle accumulation within at least 10 feet of your house
2. Cut down or thin trees to create open space on your property
3. Remove tall dry grasses from the property surrounding your home
4. Remove leaves & pine needles from your gutters
5. Remove 'ladder fuels': Prune tree limbs to 6-10 feet above the ground
6. Be sure your garden hoses and gas-powered tools are all in good repair
7. Prune excess growth from your bushes and shrubs regularly

CLEAN-UP STAFF WILL ONLY ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS

- TREE-TRIMMINGS and PINE NEEDLES
- BULKY RESIDENTIAL WASTE (not commercial or business waste of any kind)
- REFRIGERATED APPLIANCES (\$30 FEE OR CERT. OF EVACUATION REQUIRED)
- RE-USABLE HOUSEHOLD GOODS & CLOTHES (Big Brothers Big Sisters of Flagstaff will collect donations)

RECYCLING ACCEPTED

RE-USABLE HOUSEHOLD GOODS & CLOTHES (Big Brothers Big Sisters of Flagstaff will collect donations)
RESIDENTIAL RECYCLABLES SUCH AS ALUMINIUM & TIN CANS, PLASTICS 1-7, NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPER, JUNK MAIL, AND CRUSHED CARDBOARD BOXES.

- CONSUMER PRODUCTS

PLEASE NOTE THE LANDFILL CANNOT ACCEPT

- AMMUNITION
- ASBESTOS
- BROKEN FLUORESCENT BULBS
- BIOHAZARDOUS WASTES
- TIRES (TIRES WITHOUT RIMS CAN BE BROUGHT TO THE COUNTY WASTE TIRE YARD ON PENSTOCK STREET IN FLAGSTAFF ON WEDNESDAYS, 8-4:30)
- COMPRESSED GASES
- RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS
- UNKNOWN CHEMICALS
- ROCKS OR CONCRETE BLOCKS
