2. Site visit to the Pushmataha Building (1960), local Historic Landmark No. 15, located at 360 Brewer Road, Sedona, Arizona (Parcel # 401-20-028A Coconino County). The purpose of the site visit is to give members of the Historic Preservation Commission an opportunity to observe this building prior to consideration of an application for funding through the Historic Preservation Small Grant Program.
3. Site visit to the Van Ess Home (1964), local Historic Landmark No. 23, located at 280 Zane Grey Drive, Sedona, Arizona in the Sedona West Subdivision (Parcel # 408-06-090 Yavapai County). The purpose of the site visit is to give members of the Historic Preservation Commission an opportunity to observe this house prior to consideration of an application for funding through the Historic Preservation Small Grant Program.
