



PARK RULES AT A GLANCE

For and inclusive list of park rules please reference Chapter 12.30 of the Sedona City Code

Park hours: Unless otherwise posted, parks shall be open daily to the public from dawn until dusk, with the exception of Posse Grounds Park, which shall be open from dawn until 10:00p.m.

Domestic animals: must be leashed at all times; are not permitted on athletic fields; and owners are responsible for the clean-up of excrement.

Glass: Glass bottles and containers are not allowed.

Prohibited Substances: No alcohol or illegal substances.

Camping: Overnight camping and/or parking is not allowed on park premises.

Weapons: Prohibited in parks and/or recreation facilities.

Smoking: The city may prohibit smoking in any or all areas within a city park by posting signs stating such.

Nonmotorized vehicles – Roller skates – Skateboards – Roller blades.

No person shall operate skateboards, roller blades, roller skates, bicycles, scooters or any rolling vehicles in a city park where such activity is specifically prohibited by appropriate posting, or in an unsafe manner so as to infringe upon the safety of themselves or others.

Signs & Decorations: posting or attachment of any sign, poster, bill, advertisement or directional flagging to any park sign, sign post or facility is prohibited.

Golf: No one can use any portion of a park or recreation facility for golfing purposes.

Trash: It is unlawful to litter at a park or facility. Users are responsible for returning facility to an as-found condition. Dumping or depositing household or commercial trash on or at a park or recreation facility, or in dumpsters or trash receptacles provided is prohibited.

Vandalism: Those who commit vandalism in the parks or recreation facilities will be prosecuted!

Fire: No open fires are permitted. Charcoal may only be used in fixed grills provided in city parks and charcoal fires shall be attended at all times. For current fire restrictions, contact Sedona Fire District at (928) 282-6800.

Commercial Activity: No person may use a city park or recreation facility for the purpose of giving a lesson or hosting a program for compensation or fees of any sort, except when lessons or programs are offered as part of a recreation program sponsored by the city.
