Military Service Park at Jack Jameson Memorial Park Inscription Application

The Military Service Park honors those citizens of the greater Sedona area who have honorably served in the United States Military. All five branches of the Military are represented.

Proof of military service and Sedona residency will be required with your application. Acceptable forms of documentation include a copy of DD Form 214 (see below) and a letter of residency. Letter of residency should include the address and years the veteran resided in Sedona and **does not** require notarization or references.

To submit this form with payment, hand deliveries can be accepted at the Parks & Recreation Office, 525 Posse Ground Road, or mailed to City of Sedona, c/o Military Service Park, 102 Roadrunner Drive, Sedona, AZ 86336. Each inscription may have one line of text (veterans name only). Rank will not be included. Placement of the inscription on the Military Service Recognition Wall will be determined in the order in which purchase is received. **This is a non-refundable order.**
