The City of Sedona is continuing to construct shared-use pathways to promote walkability and bike-ability, and to encourage non-vehicular modes of travel to alleviate congestion. Shelby Drive Shared-Use Path will widen the existing sidewalk along Shelby Drive between Sedona Recycles and 89A.

Status: We are currently in the 60% design stage for the extension of the Shelby Drive Shared-Use Path, which was completed in 2023 under the Shelby Drive Roadway Improvements Project. This project will extend the existing 10' wide concrete pathway, which currently terminates at the recycling center, further north to connect to Whippet Way. The path is anticipated to continue on the east side of Shelby Drive for the majority of the alignment, but will cross to the west side near Whippet Way to avoid conflicts with utilities and structures. Survey and feasibility was completed by SEC Inc. This project has been awarded \$500,000 in Congressional grant funding for construction. The project has been initiated through ADOT. Currently working to obtain easements
