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**Sedona in Motion 11P – Brewer Rd Shared Use Path** **FY25 CIP Update**

This is a part of the ST&PS system and recommended in the updated Trails and Pathways Master Plan. Completing this segment would provide a safe multimodal facility for Brewer Road. This is an area that experiences high volumes of pedestrian and bicycle use.

As part of the Sedona Trails & Pathways System (ST&PS), the City of Sedona built Phase 1 of the path from Ranger Road to the Ranger Station Park in 2024. Now, the city is designing Phase 2 of the path, which will extend from Ranger Station Park along Brewer Road to the Brewer Trailhead on the Coconino National Forest.

The shared-use path will be constructed with concrete. This project will allow safer pedestrian access along Brewer Road and will continue to make Sedona a more walkable and bikeable community.

The City applied for and received a Federal Transportation Alternative Grant in the amount of \$122,192 (94.3%) with a City match of \$7,386 (5.7%) for design completion of this needed project. Design is anticipated to be completed summer 2025. The City is in the application process for another grant to pay for the majority of construction.
