

Zero Waste Guidelines for City Hosted Events

We ask that all vendors make every effort to comply with our Zero Waste Guidelines, as our goal for City of Sedona Special Events is to be Zero Waste! Please read through the following information before the event.

- **The city of Sedona will be providing vendors with bamboo cutlery.** Please refrain from using plastic cutlery. Bamboo utensils will be restocked throughout the event as needed.
- **Vendors are asked to refrain from selling bottled water.** A water bottle refill station will be provided at the event to reduce the consumption of bottled water. We are recommending event goers to bring their own reusable water bottles.
- **Please separate back-of-house recycling throughout the event.**
 - Acceptable items for recycling:
 - Clear, brown, and green glass bottles or jars
 - Any aluminum, or steel cans, containers, or foil
 - Plastic #1 & #2 bottles only
 - Plastic #5 containers, bottles & jugs
 - Cardboard boxes and paper
 - ALL OF THESE ITEMS MUST BE CLEANED AND NOT SOILED.
(i.e. no greasy cardboard)
- **A 5-gallon bucket will be given to all vendors to collect items for composting.**
 - Acceptable items for composting:
 - Fruits and vegetables
 - Grains and bread
 - Egg shells
 - Coffee grounds
 - Paper napkins
 - Paper plates and containers (no wax-lined paper items)
- **At the end of the event, please leave any bagged trash, compost buckets, and recyclables outside your truck/stand,** and our staff/volunteers will take it for further sorting.
- **Used cooking oil?** Please dispose of used cooking oil at a grease trap.
