

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-15
A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEDONA,
ARIZONA, APPROVING APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, AND EXPENDITURE OF A
AZ STATE PARKS OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE (OHV) COMPETITIVE GRANT
PROGRAM IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE U.S. FOREST SERVICE FOR THE
BROKEN ARROW IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEDONA, ARIZONA, hereby:

Section 1. Approves the filing of an application for motorized or non-motorized assistance;

Section 2. Certifies that the application is consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs for motorized/nonmotorized trails facility development; and

Section 3. Agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the Parks as a part of the application process; and


Section 4. Certifies that City of Sedona will comply with all appropriate state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application; and

Section 5. If applicable, certifies that City of Sedona has matching funds; and

Section 6. Appoints the City Manager as agent of Sedona City Council to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

Section 7. Authorizes and approves the acceptance and expenditure of the AZ State Parks Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Competitive Grant Program in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service for Broken Arrow Improvement Project.
